Flowers/Foliage: Clusters of light pink flowers through the summer against yellow and green variegated foliage that matures to ivory and green.

Growth Habit: Moderate grower reaching an average size of 4-5 feet tall with a similar spread.

Use: Great feature plant for small gardens or borders.

Exposure: Sun

Hardiness: Zone 6

Ardisia crenata 'sPg-3-001'

Features: Unique foliage and seven months of berries. Attractive to wildlife.

Flowers/Foliage: Pale pink flowers in spring contrast against hot pink new growth that darkens to a deep red. Fruits in fall.

Growth Habit: Slow grower, reaching 18 to 30 inches tall by 12 to 24 inches wide.

Use: An excellent small shrub for shady southern gardens or an ornamental container selection to brighten up winter indoors.

Exposure: Shade to Partial Shade

Hardiness: Zone 8

Ardisia japonica 'sPg-3-011'

Features: Evergreen groundcover with unique foliage and seven months of berries. Attractive to wildlife.

Flowers/Foliage: Burgundy new growth that matures to gold with green margins.

Growth Habit: Slow grower, reaching 12 to 18 inches tall by 30 to 36 inches wide.

Use: An excellent groundcover for shady southern gardens or an ornamental container selection to brighten up winter indoors.

Exposure: Shade



Use: Works well in mass plantings, as a specimen plant, or in a container.
Exposure: Sun to Partial Shade

Orange Rocket Barberry PP18411

Berberis thunbergii 'Orange Rocket'

Features: Drought tolerant and rust resistant.
Foliage: Small red leaves that turn a ruby red in autumn.
Growth Habit: Upright, columnar shrub, reaching 6 to 8 feet tall by 2 feet wide.
Use: Works well in mass plantings, as a specimen plant, or in a container.
Exposure: Sun
Hardiness: Zone 5



Tiny Gold Barberry PP17084

Berberis thunbergii 'Tiny Gold'

Features: Drought tolerant and rust resistant.
Foliage: Bright sunshine yellow foliage.
Growth Habit: Slow grower, reaching 2 feet tall and wide.
Use: Works well in the landscape as border plantings, as feature in small gardens or in mixed containers.
Exposure: Sun to Partial Shade
Hardiness: Zone 4



Asian Moon Sterile Butterfly Bush

Buddleia x 'Asian Moon'

Features: Fragrant blooms attract wildlife. Non-invasive variety.
Flowers/Foliage: 3-4 inch lavender blooms cover the shrub throughout summer.
Growth Habit: Vigorous grower, reaching an average size of 4-6 feet tall by 3-5 feet wide.
Use: Fantastic mixed shrub border.
Exposure: Sun
Hardiness: Zone 5



Fourth of July Butterfly Bush

Buddleia davidii 'Grefoj'

Features: Fragrant blooms attract wildlife.
Flowers/Foliage: Pink, blue and white blooms all summer.
Growth Habit: Vigorous grower, reaching 5 to 10 feet tall and wide.
Use: Fantastic mixed shrub border.
Exposure: Sun
Hardiness: Zone 5

Blue Heaven Butterfly Bush PP22069
Buddleia x 'Podaras #8'

Features: Non-invasive variety. Heat and drought tolerant.

Flowers: Blue blooms cover this shrub all summer.

Growth Habit: Compact, dwarf shrub, reaching 24 to 30 inches tall and wide.

Use: Fantastic mixed shrub border.

Exposure: Sun

Hardiness: Zone 5



Tutti Fruitti Butterfly Bush PP22177
Buddleia x 'Podaras #13'

Features: Non-invasive variety. Heat and drought tolerant.

Flowers: Bright fuchsia-pink blooms all summer.

Growth Habit: Compact, dwarf shrub, reaching 24 to 30 inches tall and wide.

Use: Fantastic mixed shrub border.

Exposure: Sun

Hardiness: Zone 5



Emerald Knoll™ Boxwood PPAF
Buxus 'RLH-BI'

Features: Hardy, deer resistant evergreen with year-round interest.

Foliage: Rich, emerald color holds throughout winter and does not bronze.

Growth Habit: Mounding spreader, reaching 18 to 24 inches tall by 36 to 48 inches wide.

Use: Great for small gardens or borders.

Exposure: Sun

Baby Gem Boxwood PP21159
Buxus microphylla var. japonica 'Gregem'

Baby Gem is the gold standard for valuable garden shrubs. The vigorous little-leaf boxwood has an exceptionally dense, multi-branched habit, is easy to grow and robust in the landscape overall.

Baby Gem's tiny, black-green foliage is abundant and adds a distinctive note to the landscape, retaining its color particularly well in winter. This fine-textured broadleaf evergreen grows as tall as it is wide, resembling a little green muffin.

The vibrant green hue provides an exceptional backdrop for brilliant annual and perennial flowers. Other splendid characteristics include deer resistance and tolerance of dry soils once established.

Features: Deer resistant, evergreen foliage provides year-round interest.

Flowers/Foliage: Tiny, black-green foliage

Growth Habit: Moderate grower, reaching a maintainable size of 4 feet tall and wide.

Use: Excellent for border and focal areas.

Exposure: Partial Sun

Hardiness: Zone 5

Buxus microphylla 'Grebora'

Features: Deer resistant, evergreen foliage provides year-round interest.
Flowers/Foliage: Bright green foliage.
Growth Habit: Slow grower, reaching an average size of 2-3 feet tall by 3-4 feet wide.
Use: Excellent for border and focal areas.
Exposure: Sun
Hardiness: Zone 5

Features: Deer resistant, evergreen foliage provides year-round interest.
Flowers/Foliage: Bright green foliage with gold edges.
Growth Habit: Slow grower, reaching an average size of 2 feet tall and wide.
Use: Great for small gardens or borders.
Exposure: Sun
Hardiness: Zone 5



Wine Spritzer™ Beautyberry
Callicarpa dichotoma 'sPg-3-013'

Features: Striking variegated foliage and purple berries in the fall.
Flowers: Delicate lavender blooms in summer followed by purple berries.
Growth Habit: Moderate to vigorous grower, reaching 6 feet tall.
Use: Works well in the landscape as a screen, in mass plantings or as feature.
Exposure: Sun to Partial Shade
Hardiness: Zone 5



Snazzy Brass™ Trumpet Creeper
Campsis radicans 'Gresnbr'


Features: Provides excellent fall color and is attractive to hummingbirds.
Flowers/Foliage: Yellow, trumpet-shaped blooms from late summer to early fall.
Growth Habit: Vigorous climber, reaching 25 to 30 feet long when supported.

Exposure: Sun
Hardiness: Zone 4

Campsis radicans 'Takarazuka Fresa'

Features: Compact, tame trumpet vine. Attracts birds and hummingbirds.
Flowers/Foliage: Showy red-orange flowers from late summer to early fall.
Growth Habit: Moderate climber, reaching 6 feet by 5 feet wide.
Use: Works well on a small trellis.
Exposure: Sun
Hardiness: Zone 5

Summer Jazz™ Gold Trumpet Creeper
Campsis radicans 'Takarazuka Gold'

Features: Compact, tame trumpet vine. Attracts birds and hummingbirds.
Flowers: Showy rare yellow blooms from late summer to early fall.
Growth Habit: Moderate climber, reaching 3 feet tall and wide.
Use: Works well on a small trellis.
Exposure: Sun
Hardiness: Zone 5





Madame Rosy® Trumpet Creeper PP18394
Campsis x 'HOMR'

Features: Continuous flowering from spring to fall.
Flowers: Clusters of rose-red flowers.
Growth Habit: Vigorous climber, reaching 10 to 15 feet.
Use: Works well on a trellis or pergola.
Exposure: Sun
Hardiness: Zone 5



Garden Glow Dogwood
Cornus hesseyii 'Garden Glow'

Features: Year-round interest.
Flowers: Small clusters of white flowers in early summer.
Growth Habit: Slow grower reaching an average size of 2 to 3 feet tall and wide.
Use: Use to brighten a shady area and provide fall color.
Exposure: Partial Shade
Hardiness: Zone 4



Irish Setter™ Dogwood
Cornus racemosa 'J.N. Red Stem'

Features: Fall color and winter interest.
Flowers: Small clusters of white flowers in early summer.
Growth Habit: Vigorous grower, reaching an average size of 12 feet tall and wide.
Use: Use to brighten a shady area and provide fall color.
Exposure: Partial Shade
Hardiness: Zone 3



Northern Borders™ Cotoneaster
Cotoneaster horizontalis 'Variegatus'

Features: Semi-evergreen groundcover. Colorful fall foliage.
Foliage: Unique white variegation on small green leaves. Insignificant flowering.
Growth Habit: Slow grower, reaching 2 to 3 feet tall by 5 to 8 feet wide.
Use: Use as a unique groundcover or for a border in larger landscapes.
Exposure: Sun
Hardiness: Zone 5




Spring Frost™ Distylium PPAF
Distylium x 'sPg-3-007'

Features: Spreading evergreen shrub with late winter interest.
Flowers/Foliage: Red tassel-like blooms and white-tinged new growth in early spring.
Growth Habit: Spreading grower, reaching 2 feet tall by 3 to 4 feet wide.
Use: Perfect as a foundation planting or small hedge.
Exposure: Sun
Hardiness: Zone 7



Showy Border™ Forsythia
Forsythia x intermedia 'Spectabilis'

Features: Vigorous, drought tolerant shrub. Earliest spring bloomer.
Flowers: Large bright yellow flowers that curl slightly at the tip.
Growth Habit: Moderate growth rate, reaches an average size of 8-10 feet tall by 8-10 feet wide.
Use: Great for borders, mass plantings or screens.
Exposure: Sun
Hardiness: Zone 5





Crown Jewel Gardenia PP19896
Gardenia augusta 'Crown Jewel'

Features: Fragrant blooms attract wildlife.
Flowers: Double white, fragrant blooms in early summer.
Growth Habit: Low, spreading habit, reaching an average size of 2 feet tall by 4 feet wide.
Use: Used as a focal item in small landscapes and gardens.
Exposure: Sun to Partial Shade
Hardiness: Zone 6
